As the exhibition operator and a PCBU, WellingtonNZ's duty of care to our workers, clients, service delivery partners, suppliers and public includes pursuit of best practice to achieve a healthy and safe environment for all within our exhibition footprint.

It is essential to consult, cooperate and coordinate with other PCBUs whose workers are affected by our activities. This includes you, our visiting groups and suppliers.

Our success in health and safety depends on everybody being accountable for the wellbeing of others while they are in our venues. We all have a right to a healthy and safe work environment, and the only way we can achieve this is by working together.
